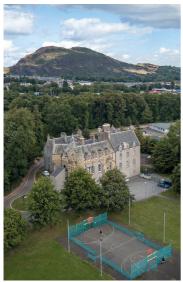

THE MAIN HALL

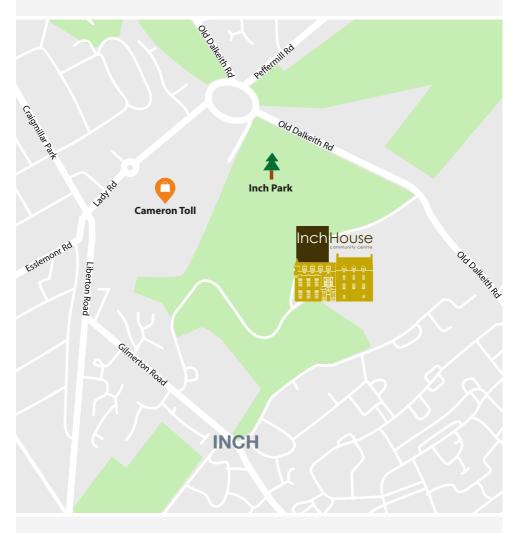
Room size: 14.5m X 6m.
